

TRIDENT RETRIEVERS™
SALES AGREEMENT AND HEALTH GUARANTEE

This agreement is made between Mark Hotaling of Trident Retrievers (Breeder), hereafter referred to as "Seller", and _____, hereafter referred to as "Purchaser".

In consideration of a purchase price of eight hundred dollars (\$ 800) the Seller transfers all rights, privileges and responsibilities associated with the ownership of the male / female Labrador Retriever as of the date specified below. All paperwork necessary for a FULL registration with the American Kennel Club is included in the purchase price.

Seller guarantees to original Purchaser the dog specified above to be free of:

- Hip and/or Elbow Dysplasia, as evaluated by the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals (OFA)
- Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA) and/or Congenital Cataract, as certified by a Veterinary ophthalmologist (must be an ACVO Diplomat)

until January 15, 2013 (3 years from birth).

In the event of emergence of any above conditions, diagnosed by a licensed veterinarian chosen by the Purchaser, on or before January 15, 2013 (3 years from birth), Purchaser shall immediately notify Seller of such condition and diagnosis. Seller shall replace the dog with another puppy of equal value and similar quality, and shall be the next such available puppy. The replacement is subject to the following:

1. Seller, at his option, may require the Purchaser to forward all medical records, x-rays, and other information relied upon for the diagnosis to Seller for a secondary opinion from a licensed veterinarian. Seller also has the option, at his expense, to require the dog be examined by a licensed veterinarian. Expenses for the initial diagnosis and shipping of all records, x-rays, and other information relied upon for the diagnosis are the responsibility of the Purchaser. Seller shall return all medical records to Purchaser at Sellers expense. Expenses for transportation of the dog to and from a second examination are the responsibility of the Seller.
2. In the event both veterinarians arrive at the same diagnosis the dog shall be replaced with another puppy of equal value and similar quality, and shall be the next such available puppy by Seller to Purchaser.
3. In the event there are differing diagnoses Purchaser may request a third examination by a licensed veterinarian agreeable to the Seller. All expenses associated with this third examination and diagnosis shall be the responsibility of the Purchaser. The diagnosis resulting from this third examination will be binding.
4. Purchaser agrees to provide proof that dog has been spayed / neutered prior to Seller replacing the dog.
5. Dog must not have been bred. If bred prior to claim, guarantee is void.
6. Purchaser agrees that no American Kennel Club registration will be given to any offspring of dog whelped after date of initial diagnosis.
7. Dog must be registered to original Purchaser at time of diagnosis.
